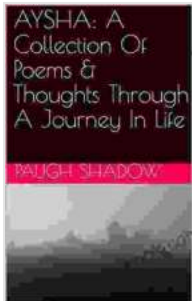

## **Later Years**

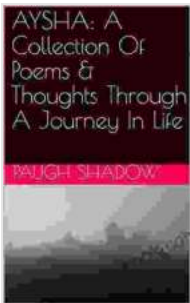
As twilight descends, and hair turns gray,
