


Rubella





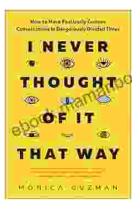
