Schlechter Variation

1. e4 d5 2. Nf3 Bg4 3. Qh5 Nf6 4. Bc4 Qe7 5. Qg3 Bxf3 6. Bxf3 Qf6

In the Schlechter Variation, Black develops their queen to f6, aiming to control the diagonal and protect the d5-pawn. White needs to find ways to break Black's defense and exploit the early queen move.

Strengths and Weaknesses

Strengths:

* Early queen development * Control of the central squares * Unexpected and surprising * Can lead to quick checkmating attacks

Weaknesses:

* Sacrifice of a pawn * Black has several variations to defend * Can be risky if Black plays accurately * Requires good tactical vision and quick decision-making

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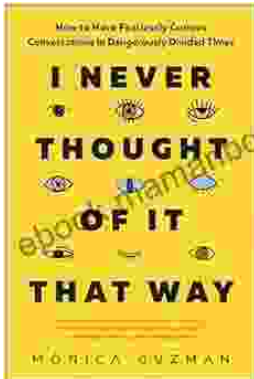
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
