The Impact

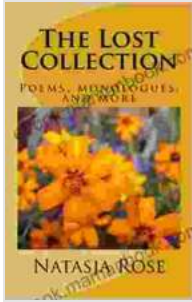

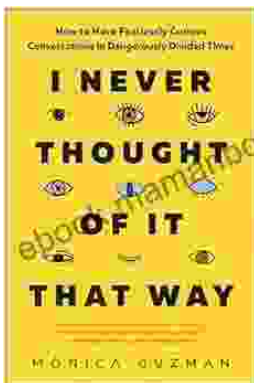
